## HONEYWELL RECEIVES NOTICE TO PROCEED TO SUPPORT SANDIA NATIONAL LABORATORIES

ALBUQUERQUE, NM, Jan. 25, 2017 -- National Technology & Engineering Solutions of Sandia (NTESS) LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Honeywell International, is pleased that the Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA) has issued the Notice to Proceed to begin transition activities for the management and operation of <a href="Sandia National Laboratories">Sandia National Laboratories</a> (SNL).
